Cardinia Shire Council together with Emerald U3A have taken steps to reduce the risk of spreading COVID-19 within the Hills Hub. We operate under this COVID Safe plan which is available on our U3A website.
It is your responsibility to be aware of Victorian Government rules regarding COVID.
Only double vaccinated members are permitted to attend classes in person at the Hills Hub. Proof of vaccination is required and will be checked by a Cardinia Shire Council Covid Marshall during public opening times. At all other times the tutor or tutor nominated person will check the proof of vaccination.
Please do not attend any Emerald U3A activity or class if you are displaying any symptoms of illness (fever, chills, sore throat, cough, runny nose, loss of sense of smell)
Please do not attend any Emerald U3A activity or class if you have had any household or household like contact with a confirmed case
Please do not attend any Emerald U3A activity or class if you have been advised to isolate by the Department of Health
Practice good hygiene (hand sanitiser will be available for use), avoid physical greetings and observe a physical distance of 1.5 metres
Wear a face mask when indoors as directed by the Victorian Government.
Please check in via QR code prior to your meeting
If you have COVID symptoms you must get tested, either at a COVID testing site or with a rapid antigen test.
If you tested positive using a rapid antigen test, you must report your result to the Department of Health online , or call 1800 675 398 . You don't need to report your result if you tested positive from a PCR test. You must isolate for 7 days from the date you got your rapid antigen test or PCR test.
Household and household-like contacts must isolate at home for 7 days.
If you test positive to COVID-19, you must tell the social contacts who you spent time with while you were infected. Social contacts are People you know who you spent 15 minutes with face to face, or more than 2 hours with in the same indoor space, while you were infectious. PLEASE INFORM THE TUTORS OF ANY GROUPS YOU ATTENDED WHILE INFECTIOUS.
